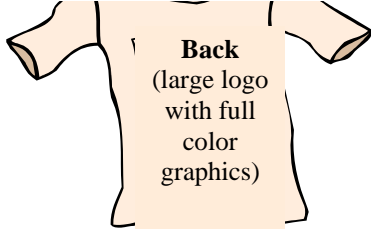
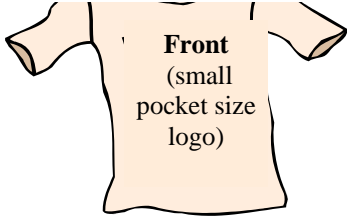

## COMPETITION GUIDELINES

1. **The entry form must be received by April 5, 2010.** Any girls group from a local church may enter, participation does not require an organized club.
2. It is to be a group competition, not an individual competition. Only (1) entry per club/group. Groups will be competing against the same age groups (i. e. 13 - 19/YLM -vs- another 13 - 19/YLM), and so forth. Clubs/groups will be placed in divisions based on the number of participants.
3. Either original or published works are acceptable. Dramatic quality of drama selection is important: Jamboree theme should be emphasized in a creative way and ministry potential should be considered.
4. Drama selections should be three to five minutes in length. Music may be used at discretion of group. Limited props (*such as chair, stool, table, hat, cane, etc.*), costumes, and make up are permitted.
5. Lighting is limited to lights provided at the facility. Special effects lighting is limited to minimal strobe lights, black lights, and flash lights and must be provided by the group.
6. Drama selection should be thoroughly familiar to the participants. Ministry should be the focus of all participants, emphasized with enthusiasm and concentration.
7. The message of the drama selection should be communicated through posture, facial and hand gestures, and appropriate blocking. Props should be used only to enhance the piece.
8. All drama selections will be judged according to the following categories of criteria:
  - Selection - Reflection of Theme** (*Jamboree theme utilized, props, costumes, music where applicable*)
  - Enthusiasm** (*All participants effectively utilized, concentration, focus, intensity*)
  - Use of Body** (*posture/blocking, facial expressions, gestures*)
  - Message** (*understandable, character development, symbolism*)
  - Effectiveness** (*ministry potential, emotional response, pacing/rhythm*)

*(It is recommended that all groups keep a copy of this Entry Form to review during your rehearsals.)*

2. It is to be a group competition, not an individual competition. Only (1) pillow entry per group/club. Pillow will be judged against the same age groups (i. e. 13 - 19/YLM -vs- another 13 - 19/YLM), and so forth.
3. Create a decorative scrapbook reflecting the theme. Any material may be used to decorate the scrapbook including: sequins, bows, beads, flowers, cording, paint, pictures of club and individual girls etc . . . A full description of scrapbook must be provided above.
4. The entry scrapbook should include a creative cover and one page per girl in group. The individual pages should provide an **“Ultimate I.D.”** of the girl represented and include her story/testimony (i.e. when she was saved, filled with baptism of Holy Spirit, baptized in water, received healing and/or challenges she has overcome through the Lord’s presence and power in her life.
5. The scrapbook will be judged in the following areas: (The actual content will not be judged.)  
**Originality, Creativity, Reflection of Jamboree Theme & Overall Appeal/Presentation.**
6. Entries should be checked in at the registration table. You will be given a number to place on your pillow which will correspond to your entry form. All pillows will be displayed in the conference center. Please take your scrapbooks home at the end of the day.


## A Heart for Others
